	Compliance Officer Dave Morse introduced issues with the petitioners of Paper 401-23 (Maxima Auto Sales) and Paper 437-23 (Greenleaf Auto) as they have been found to be

in violation of their licenses. License violations from Maxima have been happening for years but seems recently to have gotten worse. During a recent check-in on the business, it was discovered they had 57 cars on the lot but are only licensed for 31. Maxima then used the Greenleaf property to hold 47 cars. Greenleaf does not possess an open-air parking lot license. Compliance notes are attached to the history of Paper 401-23.

Recommendation is to conditionally grant this license but to also call Maxima Auto Sales Corp to the next License Committee meeting for a necessary conversation.
