<u>347-19</u> Minutes of the Meeting Rules & Ordinance of September 10, 2019.

A motion was made by Councillor Winslow, seconded by Councillor Condon, that the Committee Minutes be tabled. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

348-19 Minutes of the Meeting Rules & Ordinance of September 16, 2019.

A motion was made by Councillor Winslow, seconded by Councillor Condon, that the Committee Minutes be tabled. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Business

Ordinance: Be it hereby ordained that Section 6.45 of the Revised
Ordinances of 1991 as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following:

- 1. The building commissioner and the fire department shall sign and approve the certified plot plan submitted with the license application.
- 2. That the principal of each dealership shall submit with the application a current CORI report issued by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for review, inspection and approval by the City Council.
- 3. License fee for Class I, II and III shall be increased to \$200.00 per year.
- 4. Each Class I, II and III dealer at the time of application will pay a \$100.00 inspection fee.
- 5. That each new applicant shall pay a onetime application fee of \$50.00.
- 6. That no more than twenty-eight (28) licenses shall be issued; in addition to the sixteen (16) licenses allowed under Section E; (so called grandfathered licenses).

Councillor Murphy

The number of licenses allowed above the grandfathered licenses be reduced from 28 to 27.

A motion was made by Councillor Condon, seconded by Councillor Camell, that the Ordinance be recommended favorably as amended. The motion carried by a unanimous vote. Councillor Condon's amendment motion was that the number of licenses allowed outside of the grandfathered licenses be reduced to 27, Councillor Camell second the motion, motion passed 5-0. Councillor Winslow made a motion to amend that the fee structure be adopted but grandfathered licenses not be subject to the \$50 application fee and the \$100 inspection fee, only the \$200 yearly application fee. Councillor Camell seconded the motion, motion carried 5-0.

Order: That the City of Malden look to create and establish a "Dig one policy" for the upgrade to 5g.

A motion was made by Councillor Camell, seconded by Councillor Condon, that the Order be tabled. The motion carried by a unanimous vote. Director Knox wanted to get more information on the Dig one policy. Councillor Spadafora will send out more information to the Committee members.
