The Human Rights and Fair Housing Commission is established pursuant to the *City of Malden Municipal Code ("MCC") 2.16.100*. This proposed amendment revises the composition of said Commission.

Proposed Revisions to MCC 2.16.100 (B):

- B. The Commission shall be composed of seven members, three of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor. and four of whom shall be appointed by the City Council. Collectively, the members shall be representative of the most recent Census demographics of Malden in terms of race, gender, age, immigration status, and other relevant factors. The composition shall be as follows: The Mayor shall appoint
 - 1. A representative of the Malden Housing Authority who shall serve until their successor is appointed; and
 - 2. A Malden-based <u>(residency or business based)</u> representative of the National Association of Realtors, who shall serve for a term of three (3) years until their successor is appointed and qualified. <u>The Member must maintain NAR membership during the term of their appointment and have a current real estate license in good standing;</u>
 - 3. one <u>Three</u> Malden residents at large, preferably an attorney, subject to Council confirmation, who shall serve for a term of three (3) years <u>until</u> their successors <u>have been appointed</u>. for one year from the date of appointment. The City Council shall appoint a representative of the Chamber of Commerce, a representative of a Malden based disability advocacy organization,
 - 4. <u>A licensed</u> attorney that is either a resident of the city of Malden or working at a Malden based organization and shall serve for a term of three (3) years until their successor has been appointed;

5. A representative of a Malden-based organization providing services to elderly people, who shall serve for a term of three (3) years until their successors are appointed and qualified,

Members may be removed, with or without cause, in the same manner in which they were appointed.
