[211-19](#) Order: Be it hereby ordained that Section 9.36 (*Storage Containers*) of the Revised Ordinances of 1991 as amended, be hereby further amended by striking portions and inserting language to Section 9.36. (Per attached document).

A motion was made by Councilor Crowe to strike Section "C" (which is missed tabled should be section "D") and replace the same with the newly drafted section "c" (which is missed tabled should be section "D") The motion carried by a unanimous vote
