Be it Ordained that Section 11.35 of the R.O. of 1991 be amended relative to removal of snow and ice from sidewalks.

A motion was made by Matheson, seconded by O'Malley, that the Ordinance be amended that section 1a after the word "ended" strike "and" and insert "or". The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Matheson, seconded by O'Malley, that the Ordinance be amended that in sections 1b and 1c "forty-two (42) inches" be changed to "thirty-six (36) inches". The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Matheson, seconded by O'Malley, that the Ordinance be amended in Section 2a strike "first offense- \$50" and insert "first offense of the season shall be a written warning". The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Matheson, seconded by O'Malley, that the Ordinance be amended by striking in Section 1b "in accordance with the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements" and "to accommodate wheelchair passage". The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Matheson, seconded by O'Malley, that the Ordinance be amended in Section 1c strike remainder of sentence after "sidewalk". The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

A motion was made by O'Malley, seconded by DeMaria, that the Ordinance be recommended favorably as amended. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.
