Project: Malden River Works Construction

The City of Malden Community Preservation Committee ("CPC") is pleased to inform you that on November 29, 2023 the CPC voted 8-1 to recommend for approval to City Council that the City of Malden, OSPCD, be awarded \$983,000 to construct a new publicly open space along the river while incorporating climate resiliency measures to protect the adjacent DPW Yard. The Malden River Works project was discussed at a Public Hearing held on October 18, 2023.

In reaching their decision, the CPC found that the project meets eligibility requirements and aligns with the priorities stated in Malden's Community Preservation Plan. The CPC recommends this project with the following conditions:

1. All construction costs funded with CPA Funds shall be spent on the open space portions of the project, and not on portions of the DPW rehabilitation.

The following project summary describes the project proposal recommended for CPA funding:



Project Description



The goal of this project is to construct a vibrant, climate-resilient public riverfront park for all. This project will reduce climate vulnerability by introducing nature-based solutions to the area including green stormwater infrastructure to reduce surface flood risk, increased tree canopy to mitigate the urban heat island effect, restored riparian landscape, and an elevated greenway path to serve as a flood barrier from sea level rise.

The project also exemplifies a new model for community-led design in Malden that centers the leadership of communities of color through the MRW Steering Committee. To date, the MRW project has engaged over 1,000 community members, through 7 public meetings that have been attended by nearly 400 residents, 700 survey responses, and on-site activities that have reached over 100 people.

The entire project to date has been funded through private, state, and local grants including two Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness (MVP) Action Grants, an Accelerating Climate Resiliency Grant, the MIT Leventhal City Prize, and a FY22 Malden CPA award for \$200,000 for design. To date, the applicant has already completed a 90% design plan. This specific recommendation for CPA funding will construct the park according to the design plan. An award of CPC funds may meet the local match requirement of other grants that the City received.


