The Registrar of Voters oversees census and voter registration data to assure compliance with state and federal election law. It also conducts recounts in disputed elections. The Board has statutory oversight of voter registration street listing and election administration. The Board works in conjunction with the City Clerk's office to Establish policies and procedures that assure fairness and impartiality in the implementation and administration of these programs. The Board meets a minimum of twice a year on election days and additionally as needed. The Board meets during the state primary and presidential elections to fulfill the statutory obligation of validating and counting e-ballots cast by uniformed service persons and overseas citizens. Additional meetings are required when there is a request for recount of votes cast at elections or major policy changes resulting from amendments to election laws.


