120-25 Minutes of December 3, 2024 to be approved.

A motion was made by Councillor Winslow, seconded by Councillor O'Malley, that the Committee Minutes of December 3, 2025 be tabled. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Business

The Finance Committee will meet with Charles Ranaghan, CFO/Controller to present recent years' financial data for the city and discuss long term financial trends.

The committee met with Charles Rangahan, CFO/Controller. Chuck brought a presentation to the meeting and started the conversation on high level dollar value expenses on a year to year basis. (see attached)

We have built reserves up over the past ten years with our debt by being fiscally prudent with our investments. This allowed us the flexibility to use our reserves to appropriate money to continue the road work in the City. He cautioned with ARPA expiring we have

had to use free cash every year to balance an operating budget. The free cash will not be around forever.

Councillor McDonald said you and the Mayor have been bringing us the past couple of years smaller bond measures contributing to this stable debt payment load is it your expectation that will continue so that our debt payment stays steady with what you are projecting here is just based on existing debt.

Chuck clarified with existing debt he brought up ARPA \$45mill that we have had the luxury of doing a lot of great projects. Is it realistic to assume that over the next four fiscal years we are not going to have the bonds to do ongoing projects probably not so those projected numbers are projections knowing what we need today not knowing what we need a year from now that we don't have the luxury of using ARPA funds.
