Christenson, hereby conveys to the City of Malden a certain parcel of land owned by the City of Malden, known as Trafton Park, located between Granite Street and Jacob Street in the City of Malden, on Assessor's Map 142, Block 669, Lot 901, formerly known as Granite Street Property and Maplewood gravel lot, dedicated by the City of Malden Park Commission as William Austin Trafton Memorial Park on November 11, 1936, said conveyance being for purposes of permanently dedicating said City of Malden land to the public, for park, playground, sports, recreation and physical education purposes pursuant to MGL c. 45 §14, which land is bounded and further described as follows:
