Other Business

Continue discussions relating to Class I, II & III Licenses.

Councillor Murphy opened the discussion on the Class II Licenses with the hope of continuing to address the issues with the licenses while being able to have all the applicants complying with the requirements. The owner of 99 Trucking & Towing passed away so the License will fall off. Councillor Murphy will check with the owner's prior attorney, John Froio. There have been ongoing issues with the property so while the committee is sensitive to the situation the ongoing issues with the property have not been addressed over a few years. Councillor Murphy stated there needs to be a plan. Several other licenses were addressed from a list provided by the City Clerk's office. The Compliance Officers have issued warnings to businesses that have not applied to renew their licenses. Officers Tuxbury and Morse will issue fines for those that are ignoring the warnings. A fine of \$200 will be issued for those businesses that are operating without submitting an application. A \$50 fine will be issued for those that do not have a bond which is mandated by the state. The Clerk's office will check with Nelson Miller with regards to any plot plans that have been approved.
