Malden Code of City Ordinances Section 09.04.010A shall be amended by adding the following language at the end of Section A:

Notwithstanding the previous paragraph, a residential landowner may use a rain barrel to collect rainwater runoff from a roof provided the collection meets the following conditions:

- 1. The rain barrel contains a screen or other cover that prevents it from harboring for mosquitoes or other pests and being accessed by children,
- 2. The rain barrel is no larger than 55 gallons, sits at least one foot from the ground atop a base sturdy enough to hold the weight of the rain barrel when full and that prevents it from tipping,
- 3. The water is used only for non-potable purposes such as gardening and not for direct human consumption such as drinking or washing dishes, and
- 4. The owner once a year empties all water from the barrel and cleans out silt and dirt.
