A motion was made by Councillor Crowe, seconded by Councillor Condon, to suspend Council Rules for the purpose of hearing Paper 315-23. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Deborah Burke, Director of Office of Strategic Planning & Community Development, opened the discussion by first explaining the State has recently come out with new guidance which will now allow for mixed use development within the zoning under M.G.L. c. 40A, s. 3A. This evening's presentation is for informational purposes only and will not require a vote. However, a draft plan does have to be submitted to the State by September 19 for initial review.

Sarabrent McCoy and Nels Nelson, consultants from Stantec Urban Places, then proceeded with a prepared presentation, which is attached to the history of Paper 315-23.

Councillor McDonald offered feedback to the planning team that he wishes to see Malden comply with the spirit of the law and not just piece together the minimum we need to get through compliance. It is important to figure out to make it possible for people to continue to be able to afford to live in Malden and not be priced out of their hometown.

Councillor Crowe countered, regarding affordability, that it may be preferred to do just we are required to comply with 3A. She prefers not to have so many by right with the 15% affordable housing when the city can then work on other parcels with the Affordable Housing Trust to ensure 100%.

Expected to happen next is the City will file a draft with the State by September 19, public hearing in November, City Council will consider whether or not to ordain by December 19, City files with the State a complete zoning ordinance by December 31, 2023.

5. EXECUTIVE SESSION
