### Minutes to be Approved

[248-19](#) Minutes of the Meeting of April 30, 2019.

**A motion was made by Councillor Winslow that the Committee Minutes be approved. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.**

### Business

[224-19](#) Order: Be it hereby Ordained that Section 6.20 (*Amusement Machines*) of the Revised Ordinances of 1991 be hereby further amended by striking portions and inserting language to Sections 6.21, 6.22 and 6.23. (Per attached document).

**A motion was made by Councillor Crowe, seconded by Councillor Winslow, that the Ordinance be amended by striking the third, fourth, and fifth paragraphs in Subsection .1. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.**

**A motion was made by Councilor Winslow, seconded by Councilor Crowe, that the Ordinance be amended by striking "per machine" at the end of the first sentence in Subsection .2 and also striking the second sentence altogether. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.**

**A motion was made by Councillor Condon, seconded by Councillor Winslow, that the Ordinance be amended by inserting in subsection .2: "The annual fee for an amusement machine license shall be based upon the number of machines offered for operation in accordance with the following schedule: 1-25 machines \$50.00 dollars each machine. 26 and up shall be \$25.00 each machine. In addition to the \$100.00 non refundable application fee." The motion carried by a unanimous vote.**

**A motion was made by Councillor Winslow, seconded by Councillor Crowe, that the Ordinance be amended by striking, in Subsection 3, the last paragraph and inserting "Every establishment shall post a sign on the premises, so as to be clearly visible to users, a notice containing the following statement: "This machine is licensed for recreational use only. Any gambling associated with the use of this machine will result in revocation of the license for its operation." The motion carried by a unanimous vote.**

A motion was made by Councillor Crowe, seconded by Councillor Winslow, that the Ordinance be recommended favorably as amended. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Order: Be it hereby ordained that Section 9.36 (*Storage Containers*) of the Revised Ordinances of 1991 as amended, be hereby further amended by striking portions and inserting language to Section 9.36. (Per attached document).

The Committee spoke with the Building Commissioner, Nelson Miller, regarding the issue of storage containers. Topics ranged from fees to be imposed, whom should issue the permits and place said container on the property. A motion was made by Councillor Condon, seconded by Councillor Crowe, that the Ordinance be tabled. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Committee continued discussions relating to the existing Small Cell Ordinance; Attorney McNaught attended to advise committee on his findings.
