

Be it hereby ordained by the Malden City Council that the Revised Ordinances of 2020 as amended be and the same are hereby further amended as follows:

-by striking out the words “or Redevelopment Authority” as appearing in Section 2.12.010. (COMPLIANCE OFFICER; AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT)

-by adding to Section 2.08.040 (ENUMERATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSION APPOINTED OFFICERS; TERMS AND DUTIES) the following new officer

-by adding a new Section 2.12.085 as follows:

2.12.085 ~~OFFICE~~ DEPARTMENT OF STRATEGIC PLANNING AND ~~ECONOMIC~~ COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

- A. Commencing July 1, 2021 and every three years thereafter, the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the City Council, shall appoint a Director of Strategic Planning and ~~Economic~~ Community Development, who shall serve for the three years next ensuing. The Director of Strategic Planning and ~~Economic~~ Community Development shall be the executive and administrative officer of the ~~Office~~ Department of Strategic Planning and ~~Economic~~ Community Development and may, subject to funding, appoint such assistants and subordinates as may be required.
- B. The ~~Office~~ Department of Strategic Planning and ~~Economic~~ Community Development shall have the following duties and responsibilities:
 - a. Acting in the name and on behalf of the Malden Redevelopment Authority, in accordance with the agreement dated _____ between the city and the Redevelopment Authority, to:
 - i. Administer existing programs;
 - ii. Execute existing contractual obligations;
 - iii. Fulfill all other obligations on behalf of the Redevelopment Authority as might be required pursuant to said agreement;
 - b. Assisting the Mayor and City Council in preparation of an application for community development block grant funds and to administer said funds in accordance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and the Cranston-Gonzalez Housing Act of 1990;

- c. Providing administrative and technical support to the Planning Board and City Planner for ongoing review and modification of the city's Master Plan;
- d. Developing and implementing, subject to the approval of the Mayor and City Council, programs designed to meet the city's long-range goals for:
 - i. Expanding economic investment, attracting business, and enhancing employment opportunities in the city;
 - ii. Preserving and augmenting the city's housing stock, promoting affordable housing, expanding opportunities for home ownership, and preventing homelessness;
 - iii. Leading transportation planning related initiatives geared towards improving the transportation infrastructure;
 - iv. Improving the quality of life in the neighborhoods of the city;
- e. Assisting the Mayor and City Council in development and implementation of long-range capital planning for the maintenance and improvement of public services and amenities;
- e-f. Providing oversight and staffing support to the Commission on Energy Efficiency in encouraging the preservation of green spaces and clean air, promoting public awareness and advising city agencies of sustainability options and practices, and encouraging the growth of businesses that produce sustainable products and services;
- f-g. Facilitating the city and its agencies in identifying and securing state, federal and private funding sources as an alternative or supplement to the use of public funds for programs, equipment and personnel; and
- g-h. Engaging in such other related activities as the Mayor and City Council may, from time to time, require.

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
