Chair Crowe called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Minutes for the meeting of April 18, 2023

A motion was made by Councillor Sica, seconded by Councillor at Large Spadafora, that the Committee Minutes be approved. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Business

The Committee will meet to have a brief discussion on Papers 197 and 198 of Series 2023 prior to them going to a joint session of Planning Board and Rules & Ordinance.

Chair Crowe turned the meeting over to Councillor O'Malley who wished to discuss the following two papers. He began with 197-23, which is in relation to a neighborhood highway business district that pre-dated our currently zoning ordinances. The paper aims to update zoning from highway to neighborhood business. This move will allow for much of the same usage but focuses more on the types of business one would expect in a neighborhood. Examples of neighborhood business are retail shop or convenience store. The surrounding area from this parcel is zoned for residence A. Councillor O'Malley stated this small area of the four street addresses has always been a bit of a zoning outlier and he has wondered why it hasn't been updated until now.

City Planner Romero explained the Committee needs to request a legal description from the City Engineer of the parcels being considered for re-zoning with Paper 197-23. Michelle explained the description needs to include the entirety of the parcels as described in the paper and that it is needed prior to any public hearing, which is tentatively scheduled for July 12. Councillor Linehan made such a motion, seconded by

Councillor Winslow, the motion was voted unanimously.

Councillor O'Malley inquired if he would be able to make an amendment to Paper 198-23 to include drive-thrus to "No" in the Use Regulation chart. That would require the entire paper to be re-voted and referred again to Planning Board. With this, he instead decided to file a separate paper. Councillor Spadafora commented that many people rely on drive-thrus to do business in the city, for example seniors who have difficulty getting out of their cars.

Further discussion around Paper 198-23 was to explain that there are enough self storage facilities in the city and they encourage transient life styles when the city should be encouraging long term residents and home ownership.
