458-23 CPC Appropriations

Paper 458-23 Daniel Koff, Clerk of CPC explains this paper is financial housekeeping. CPA sets its budget based on estimates of the amount of amount of surcharge revenue collected and the amount over-seed from the State as a match. Those estimates are purposely conservative because we don't want to assume we are going to get more money than we are. This is standard practice and we are trying to go above and beyond to reconcile our actual funding with our estimated and make sure we are correctly appropriating 10% of our actual funding into each of the three categories. This year we had an enormous truing of the account thanks to the Controller finding \$750,000 in additional funding collected above and beyond our estimates and we wanted to make sure we are setting 10% to each of those categories and in addition the State match came in 1% higher and we added that in as well.
