The Board of Registrars are also involved on any election date with any duties especially with the end of the night with closing duties at the polls. She explained a lot of the election information comes from the State and are constantly changing.

Jessica said she could also help to help Dinah, Registrar of Voters with the spreadsheets Councillor Condon thanked Jessica for going for this position and wishes her luck Councillor Winslow said knowing how much our elections are changing this is an important position and thanks her for serving

Councillor McDonald asked if she speaks other languages.
