Councillor Winslow stated he did invite Laa Tiendaa (tenant) of property at 45 Lebanon Street to attend meeting; Gabriel Tobirio co-owner did not come to meeting; compliance officer Dave Morse discussed issues relating to petitioner and the question of whether they were selling second hand goods; Mr. Morse distributed handouts relating to information pertaining to the sale of second hand goods (consignment items); also spoke about discussions with present landlord; eviction notice, rent owned; bounced checks; Councillor Winslow noted he was told there were issues with plumbing in the space; possibly relating to holding back funds; also discussed were other fines and licenses that petitioner had not yet applied for, i.e. amusement license; also pool table license was mentioned; it was stated that the pool table was no longer on the property; Morse also mentioned a proposed new location of 888 Eastern Ave. that petitioner said he would possibly be moving into; Councillor Sica stated why would we issue license to 45 Lebanon Street if he would be moving to 888
