<u>Summary:</u> To amend Title 12.12.300 of the Code of the City of Malden, Use Regulations for Inclusionary Zoning.

<u>Purpose and Intent:</u> To encourage the creation of more affordable housing units through the amendment of the requirement to make a cash payment for the required fractional unit of Affordable Housing and the establishment of the option for a developer to provide one additional Affordable Housing Unit for the required fractional unit of Affordable Housing.

## **Text of Proposed Amendment:**

Be it hereby ordained that Title 12, Chapter 12, be amended to read as follows:

## To amend 12.12.300 Use Regulations, Inclusionary Zoning

Section G. Alternative Methods of Compliance.

- 3. Fractional Units. Where the required number of Affordable Housing Units results in a fraction of a unit, the required number shall <u>either</u> be:
  - <u>a.</u> rounded down to the nearest whole number and the difference shall be realized as a cash payment made to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund equal to the fractional unit multiplied by three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000 the current fee-in-lieu; or
  - b. rounded up to the nearest whole number.

## **Illustrative Example:**

Total Dwelling Units in Inclusionary Development: 24

Required Affordable Housing Units: 3.6

Under current provision: 3 Affordable Housing Units and a cash payment (0.6 x \$300,000) are required. Under proposed amendment: 3 Affordable Housing Units and either a cash payment (0.6 x \$300,000) or one additional Affordable Housing Unit are required.
