#### 462-19

Petition: Massachusetts Electric Company d/b/a National Grid, North Andover, MA, 150 Oliver Street, Malden, MA - Install 1 new SO pole - 150 Oliver St. in the Public Way at painted location; also to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables, and wires in the above intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as each of said petitioners may desire for distributing purposes. National Grid requests permission to construct a line of underground electric conduits, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, under and across the public way or ways hereinafter named Oliver Street. Oliver Street - Massachusetts Electric Co. d/b/a/ National Grid to install 1 SO Pole on Oliver St. beginning at a point approximately 17 ft. South of the centerline of the intersection of Springdale St. and continuing approximately 19 ft. in an east direction. Install 1 new SO pole - 150 Oliver St. in the Public Way at painted location. Also for permission to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables and wires in the above or intersection public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as each of said petitioners may desire for distributing purposes.

At the Hearing Moses Okokuro, 170 Medford Street spoke in favor of the Petition and is

a representative from National Grid.

There were no speakers in opposition of the Petition.

Mr. Okokuro answered questions from the council. Councillor O'Malley asked the Council is this what we want to be approving telephone poles for when Mr. Okokuro answered that there would be a small cell petition submitted for the pole. Councillors Winslow and Murphy voiced their opposition to the petition because of the small cell. Councillor Anderson stated more information was needed. Attorney Fallon stated that there would be a two step process, the first being approval of the pole and the second step the application needed to get approved by the council for the small cell.

A motion was made by Councillor Anderson, seconded by Councillor Murphy, that the Petition be tabled. The motion carried by the following vote:

141-20 Petition: Massachusetts Electric d/b/a National Grid - Seaview Avenue, Malden, MA

National Grid requests permission to construct a line of underground electric conduits, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, under and across the public way or ways hereinafter named Charles Street. Sea View Ave - National Grid to install 1-3" conduit off existing pole (P4258) approximately 5ft southeast towards 45 Sea View Ave.

At the Hearing Moses Okokuro, 170 Medford Street, spoke in favor of the Petition; he is also a representative of National Grid.

There were no speakers in opposition of the Petition.

Councillor Murphy is aware of the Petition and the pole being in Ward 5 she is in full support of granting.

A motion was made by Councillor Murphy, seconded by Councillor Anderson, that the Petition be granted with conditions. The motion carried by the following vote:

## Petition: Massachusetts Electric d/b/a National Grid - Charles Street and Middlesex Street Intersection, Malden, MA

National Grid requests permission to construct a line of underground electric conduits, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, under and across the public way or ways hereinafter named Charles Street. Charles St - National Grid to relocate 2 JO Poles on Charles St beginning at a point approximately 110 feet northwest of the centerline of the intersection of Charles St and Middlesex St. Relocating two (2) existing poles P5431 & P5432 approximately 55ft & 60ft respectively northwest (to opposite side) near 99 Charles St from existing location.

Also for permission to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables, and wires in the

above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as each of said petitioners may desire for

distributing purposes.

#### Sponsors: Barbara Murphy

Councillor Winslow amended the Petition to add that trees would be taken care of the side of the building and trees be added on the other side of the street and the Middlesex Street would be resurfaced. Councillor Winslow had a second amendment that he withdrew.

A motion was made by Councillor Winslow, seconded by Councillor O'Malley, that the Petition be amended. The motion failed by the following vote:

Yea: 5 - Camell, DeMaria, Linehan, O'Malley and Winslow

Nav: 6 - Anderson, Condon, Crowe, Murphy, Sica and Spadafora

Councillor Crowe discussed the project and that she along with Councillor O'Malley met representatives at the site that morning. Councillor Crowe told the committee the project is a much needed office building and has a cost of \$20 million. Councillor O'Malley voiced concern that the cable/wires would be above ground as did Councillor Winslow. Councillors Murphy, Condon, Spadafora and Anderson spoke in favor of the project

A motion was made by Councillor Crowe, seconded by Councillor Anderson, that the Petition be granted with conditions. The motion carried by the following vote:

Yea: 9 - Anderson, Camell, Condon, Crowe, DeMaria, Linehan, Murphy, Sica and Spadafora

Nay: 2 - O'Malley and Winslow
