Housing Trust Fund (AHTF) Board. There were 3 options presented,

- a- with 9 members,
- b- 7 members and
- c- 7 members with different variations of required affiliations.

The council agreed on option C, a 7 member Board with the MRA not having a member on the Board but the MRA can serve in an Administrative capacity. The members terms would not be staggard. The terms of all board members shall be two (2) years, concurrent with each other, with the exception of the Mayor or their designee which would be a four (4) year term. Councillor Camell made a motion that a minimum of 4 members be Malden residents, Councillor Winslow seconded the motion, the motion passed 4-0.

Option C with 7 members 1) mayor or designee 1) City Councillor 1) Housing Authority Rep.1) Affordable housing resident and 3) others which may include the following:

a non profit affordable housing development a real estate or finance, especially regarding affordable housing development a non-profit housing services provider.

The ordinance was recommended favorably for Option C that was presented.
