I am Michael Tran, the home owner and I live at 18 Central Ave. I am writing to object to the petition from Celco Partnership d/b/a Verizon on April 20, 2021; the installation of telecommunication equipment, antennae and appurtenant equipment as well as small wireless facilities (small cells) on the National Grid owned Utility Pole at 562 Broadway (Rte.99). This is because I have concerns over the health, comfort, and privacy of my family from how close the equipment will be to my home, as well as property values due to the article called " **Cities Are Saying No to 5G, Citing Health, Aesthetics—and FCC Bullying**" by Christopher Mims at the Wall Street Journal. After reviewing the plan, I found that I would be only around 10 steps away from the poles with the equipment.
