Councillor Anderson stated that this is why we have a City Solicitor and she had been asked her opinion. Councillor O'Malley stated there is a need to have clearer language. Councillor Condon stated we don't need to go back three years and is not in favor of referring the paper because of councillors disagreeing with the Solicitor's opinion.
