Chair Crowe opened the discussion with the Mayor's letter in support of the Ordinance change and stated that the Historical Commission has been following the protocols for 2 years. Chair Crowe turned it over to City Planner Michelle Romero. Ms. Romero told the committee the change reflects what protocols we have been following now and are straight forward.Ms. Romero continued the change would clarify the fees, review tine and

the administrative aspects of the process. Updates would become a requirement instead of asking for them. The changes would put teeth in the Ordinance and gives the Building Commissioner options to fine if there are violations, if the project is significant it would get moved to a public hearing.

Councillor McDonald stated the Historical Commission has done a good job and the process seems to be working well, the changes seem good.

The Charter School recent purchase of property in Maplewoood Square was discussed and if they were getting around demolition delay by tearing the buildings down to a vacant lot and building later. Building Commissioner Nelson talked about you can't tell them what is going there. Planner Romero talked about One Salem Street, it is currently a hole in the ground but when they come back there will be conditions. Ms. Romero continued "do not get hung up on what are they going to do there".
